Be sure to avoid viewing any properties...

That are not made of standard construction



- X Listed or graded property
- X Thatched roof
- X Caravans or house boats
- X Single skin property
- X Concrete panel or precast construction
- X Steel framed homes
- X Timber frame over 10 years old



We can only provide a Lifetime Lease option on properties that are of standard construction - bricks and mortar.

Other property types to be aware of:

- X Property next door to an abandoned or unoccupied property
- X Studio property
- X Properties without planning or building regulations in place

You should also avoid properties where local council regulations have not been adhered to, or where there may be any concerns regarding securing the cost of a lease for the future – this will minimise the risk of future stress as you settle into your new home.

Where there are issues with the freeholder



- X Property with flying freehold
- X Leases below 90 years
- X Property with unorthodox lease
- X Missing or absentee freeholders
- X Ex local authority properties (freehold or leasehold) may result in a lower saving against the market price

- X Properties which contain asbestos
- X Property above/behind/next door to commercial property
- X Property close to electricity pylons, mobile telephone masts or cell towers (standard telephone poles and wires are fine)
- X Blocks over five floors
- X On or close to major road
- X Within 500 – 1000 yards of contaminated land, substations or sewage works
- X Properties next to a petrol station
- X Property backing onto train line
- X Located next to or opposite a pub

From chemicals that are bad for your health, to businesses that are open during anti-social hours; there are a variety of issues that could be detrimental to your health and wellbeing.
